### **Current System**

- We have a unique system
- 130,000 households
  - Majority use alley dumpsters
  - 20,000 use roll carts
- Recycling picked up 1x/week
  - \$14/month (includes trash, bulk, yard waste, recycling, drop off)

### Collection

### Dumpsters

- TRASH (brown dumpsters)
  - Monday AND Thursday OR
  - Tuesday AND Friday
- RECYCLABLES (blue dumpsters)
  - Monday or Tuesday
- YARD WASTE (green dumpsters)
  - Thursday or Friday (during growing season)

### Rollcarts

-TRASH (green cart) Monday or Tuesday -RECYCLABLES (blue cart) Thursday or Friday -YARD WASTE (green cart) Wednesday (during growing season)


### **Area Cost Comparison**

Municipality	Monthly Charge	Includes
University City	\$33.00	Trash, yard, recycling, bulk
St. Charles County	\$28.00	Trash, yard, recycling
Berkeley	\$19.91	Trash, yard, recycling, bulk



### Where We Stand

- Landfilled ~141,000 tons of solid waste in CY2017
  - Recycled ~16,000 tons
- Current diversion rate is 10%
- 50% of what residents throw away can be easily recycled

### Single-Stream Recycling

Rinse containers. Discard caps and lids. Labels do not need to be removed. Do not include food contaminated materials. If in doubt, leave it out.





### **Benefits**

#### Economic

- St. Louis has more recycling/remanufacturing jobs on average compared to U.S.
- Over \$600 Million in payroll in St. Louis Metro
- Our Material Recovery Facility (MRF), where our recyclables go, is close to adding a third shift
  - Increasing our diversion rate could immediately create 18 more jobs!

## Why \$14/month?

- Ordinance 68698

### **Brightside St. Louis**

- Neighbors Naturescaping
  - Invested in plant materials and tools in 29 neighborhood gardening projects last year
  - Nearly **850** neighborhood projects established or enhanced
  - Spring 2017 we provided 200,000 annuals to neighborhoods for public planting in addition to Neighbors Naturescaping 30,000 native perennials







- Help clean-up St. Louis streets, alleys and lots by registering to organize a Blitz project in your neighborhood
  - Select your own date, location and clean up size; no project too big or small
  - Our tool loan program will supply everything you need; you and your neighbors just bring the energy!
  - Register by May 1 to be eligible for FREE flower seedlings through Blitz Bloom



### **Graffiti Removal**

- 2017 we removed from over **5,000** locations
  - That's over **360,000** sq. feet
  - Average of **72** sq. feet per location
- Well over 150,000 locations treated from program start
